

Appropriate Use of Technology

Here at MNTH students are given the opportunity to access a state of the art integrated computer network. Along with this privilege comes a heightened level of responsibility. In conjunction with the user agreement form you signed for the Manor ISD Technology Department, MNTH will take this opportunity to lay out clear and specifics issues.

Students are prohibited from all of the following actions:

- All Social Networking websites – This includes but is not limited to Facebook, MySpace, Flixster, Hi5, and MocoSpace
- All proxy server websites that are designed for, intended to, or even by chance scan our network, attempt in any way to circumvent our security policies and/or internet filters.
- Download, transfer, copy, or distribute any files that violate copyright laws.
- Any files that contains violent images, weapons, drugs, alcohol, pornography, threatening, and/or harassing statements.
- Altering, deleting, or damaging another student's shares folder.
- Uploading any personal media files to your shares folder, any computer, and or the network that are not of an education purpose.
- Logging into a computer for another student whose access has been suspended.

All of MNTH's computers and network are established for our student's educational purpose not their personal use.

Students are responsible for all of the content in their shares folder, on their jump drives, and on any computer they signed into.

Violations of the MNTH appropriate use of technology policies that are not directly related to class projects could result in any of the following actions:

- A student's computer access will be suspended for 3 days
- A student's computer access will be suspended for 5 days
- A Conference between Principal, Parent, and Student.
- Lunch detention
- Out of school suspension
- AEP placement.
