## **Press Release – Election Alert**

Travis County Clerk Dana DeBeauvoir and Interim Superintendent Mr. Andrew Kim are reminding voters in the Manor Independent School District that the election for three at-large positions on the Board of Trustees will be held Saturday, June 14, 2008. Early voting will begin on June 2, 2008. The School District, with the cooperation of the Travis County Clerk's office, asked Judge Margaret Cooper to cancel the election because of incorrect instructions on the ballot. The ballot indicated that voters could vote for 0, 1, or 2 candidates and should have read that voters could vote for 0, 1, 2, or 3 candidates. Judge Cooper granted the request and cancelled the May 10, 2008 election and ordered that the new election be held on June 14, 2008. The top three candidates, from the original six candidates who filed for election, receiving the most votes will be elected. Although early voting had begun before the error was discovered, no early votes cast in the May 10<sup>th</sup> election will be counted.

The early voting time periods will be from June 2, 2008 through June 10, 2008. The early voting locations, dates, and times will be posted and published as in any election. Applications for ballots by mail must be received by the close of business by June 6, 2008.
