
















FIVE SENSES

1st – 3rd

1. Launch Pixie. 
2. Use text boxes  to create a title page with “Five Senses” and your name.
3. Use the paint bucket  to paint the background.
4. Save 
5. Click  for a new page.
6. Create a text box  to type the name of your first sense.
7. Find 3 different stickers to represent this sense. (Ex: Pizza for taste)
8. Use text boxes  to type a sentence about each sticker.
9. Use the paint bucket  to paint the background.
10. Save. 
11. Repeat steps 4-9 for a page on each of the 5 senses and a page that tells all the senses we use with a picture. (*Ex: Pizza we can taste, smell, touch, see*)
12. Save. 
13. Click on Share  and choose Current Open Images. 
14. After saving, WebBlender  will launch.

15. Choose a Template and click in the checkbox next to *Include Title Page*. 
16. Remove the “Double click to add text” boxes from each slide.
