Parents/Guardians:

Because student leaders on the campus are considered to be role models, they must exhibit the characteristics that all students should emulate. Therefore, our campus has established the following criteria to be an officer of the leadership team at Lagos ES. You will find these criteria on the Student Evaluation Form that will be used to determine a student's eligibility to be an officer or representative on the leadership team.

Grades:

- Officers and representatives must maintain grades of 80+ in all content areas. Officers are occasionally required to miss class because they are involved in a leadership activity or project. Students who make A's and B's can afford to miss class periodically.

Citizenship:

- Citizenship must be **exemplary** because we always want students from our school to exhibit the very best citizenship when they are representing us. Students who make A's in citizenship need no reminders about the importance of good behavior.

Homework and Classwork:

- A student who has developed the habit of always having homework and classwork completed on time will be a student who is responsible to have student council projects completed on time.

Organization:

- Organization is a must for an officer. If a student is assigned a project with a deadline, the student will be expected to have it organized and ready on time. The students must have all the required materials when attending a meeting.

Teamwork:

- A leadership team member must be able to work well with others. The member must recognize that he or she may have to occasionally compromise for the greater good of the group.

Attendance:

- Attendance at school and at meetings is a must.

Punctuality:

- Officers must have the habit of always being on time to school and to meetings.

All students who want to be considered for an office on the Lagos ES StuCo/Leadership Team must ask two teachers to complete a Student Evaluation Form. One of the teachers should be the student's current homeroom teacher. The second form can go to a teacher of the student's choice.
